

2	TREASURERS REPORT
	AJ circulates the treasurers report noting that it is produced to the best of her ability as she does not have access to the bank account yet. Therefore, there may be some minor inaccuracies but by the next meeting this will not be at issue. Events from 1 st Sept are those noted as open on the treasurer's report. The total incoming so far is £2,381. Just under £800 net income after expenditure. Details are shown on the treasurer's report appended to the minutes. AJ commits to producing the Treasurers report in advance of meetings in future, to avoid any additional discussion. On expenditures, an expression of thanks is passed from Mrs Kerrs for

EM runs through the list of events circulated to those present at the meeting outlining the events per campus and where it is now further volunteers are needed. This list is attached to minutes.

For the raffle, Classes will have colours associated for donations with each class collecting items of their associated colours. A suggested item list may be posted for each class.

Elfridges will be run as an event on Monday 12th December at Hardwick and 8th December at Cambourne. AG notes that 12th is the dress rehearsal for the play at Hardwick and this is a whole school event with children across all stages either in the play or attending as audience. Committee notes this point for organisational challenges.

KE notes that for the KS1 Disco at CB there are plenty volunteers. Asks if cake sale is possible at CB site and perhaps include the choir. This is discussed, JH noting that the library has previously been used and this could be organised again.

CB will run a free family craft morning in January and include the sale of uniform. JH suggests he may run a stall during this time.

KE notes that Krispy Kreme returns will be lower for the planned sale as the cost per box has increased and may increase further

The bingo/quiz night will be run at the Cambourne Hub and work is underway to organise this. The date is not yet fixed.

Easter trails were very popular previously and will return this year. Date is TBC but will run over the Easter holiday period giving everyone time to complete their trail.

HW to run collection service for Christmas trees to move trees to Cambourne hub for chipping up as Hardwick does not currently have a collection space.

HW will run a free family even on January 14th



HW will run a family fun big breakfast towards end of school year instead of the school fayre. JH asks if the date TC could avoid 24th June.

CB will run a scaled down carnival. Date agreed with Cate Thompson. The event will include a bar.

There will be a bake sale at HW at end of the year. With the previous bake sale being well attended this is felt to be an event that can be repeated.

Yr6 hoodies to be planned for March delivery and useful for Hill top.

JH notes that clearly advertised free events is nice. It was felt that January was a long month and could be very tough for some people, for which these events are helpful and create a community spirit.

4 **FUNDING REQUESTS**

Lara Jodin; 4 staple guns. LJ asks JH if these should be provided from the stationary budget. JH agrees and will take this forward.

Role play areas; new supplies to £180 of role play areas. Passed on a show of hands.

Katherine Mitchell – Polar boat for HW site reception. Passed on a show of hands.

Kathryn Mitchel – Funding of the annual usage fee for a year and potentially into the future. A lively discussion is held where the purpose of PTA funding is discussed. It is noted that in the initial funding request the PTA funded the system but in subsequent discussions outside of meetings it was explained that

the PTA would not fund the system as an ongoing commitment. That discussion did not appear to have resulted in the ongoing commitment being included in the budget for the year. Subsequently the request is to fund this for the present year and consider whether it could be funded for future years. After discussion, the current year funding is put to a vote. The cost is £409. On a show of hands, the current year funding is approved
