1	<u>INTRODUCTION TO ATTENDEES AND APOLOGIES</u>

2	<u>TREASURERS REPORT</u>

3	<u>FUTURE EVENTS</u>
	<p>Year 6 hoodies order goes in Friday 15th March, 55 orders to date.</p> <p>Have discussed with JH for pupil premium hoodies. All pupil premium pupils will receive hoodies paid for by the premium in order that these not miss out. There will be a contribution from hoodies to school leavers event.</p> <p>Leavers event – after easter details to go out to parents.</p>



	<p>22 March - Donut and hot chocolates – Friday (Non Krispy Kreme) 144 donuts ordered. Donuts £1 and £1.50 for hot chocolate.</p> <p>Easter – Fund Raisin with a spring theme – class that raises the most gets own clothes day and 10 mins extra break time. 4	<u>FUNDING REQUESTS</u>
	<p>The committee asked members to comment on a funding request for the introduction of guinea pigs at the Hardwick site. Committee raised a number of challenges with the ethical keeping of pets and those specifically around the keeping of guinea pigs. LC contributed her experience as an asthma nurse that there can be severe challenges around allergies to hay, fur and other allergens associated. The committee were noted to be minded to vote against this funding request but that it may progress on a positive endorsement by the majority of the committee.</p>
