Firework Scratch Jr Worksheet

Create a firework display.

In this lesson, you will learn to:

- draw your own character or object
- repeat an action using the Repeat block



Getting Started

- 1. Open the Scratch Jr app.
- 2. Start a New project.
- 3. Put your finger on the cat in the middle of the screen and hold it there until a red button with a cross appears. Click on the cross to remove the cat.

Step 1: Create a Night Sky Background









paintbrush tool

- 1. Click on the background tool.
- 2. Choose the Paintbrush tool to create a new background.
- 3. Use the fill tool to create a black or dark blue background.
- 4. Choose the wiggly line and draw a white moon or some yellow stars on the background.
- 5. Click on the tick when you're finished.





Step 2: Make a Firework


- 1. Click to add a character.
- 2. Choose the Paintbrush tool to draw a colourful firework.
- 3. Name it Firework 1



4. Click on the tick when you have finished. You can click on your firework at any time and move it to a different position.

Step 3: Add the Code to Firework 1

- 1. Use the green flag block to start the program when the green flag is clicked.
- 2. Use the code blocks to **Show** and then **Hide** Firework 1.
- 3. Use the **Repeat** block to repeat it 10 times.
- 4. Use the red **End** block.



Step 4: Make Another Firework

- 1. Repeat Step 3.
- 2. This time name your firework **Firework 2**.








Step 5: Add the Code to Firework 2.

- 1. Use the green flag block to start the program when the green flag is clicked.
- 2. Use the code blocks to Hide and then Show Firework 2.
- 3. Use the Repeat block to repeat it 10 times.
- 4. Use the red End block.



Step 6: Run Your Firework Program



Click on the green flag to start your program.
