Communication, Language & Literacy

Phonics: We will be covering Phase I before introducing Phase 2 and our first few letter sounds and tricky words towards the end of this half term.

Children will be introduced to the 'Poetry Basket' as we begin to learn new poems.

We will launch 'Helicopter Stories'

Children will learn a new word each day through 'Mrs Wordsmith'.
