Year 3/4 Topic Overview- Autumn 2: Ancient Egypt

In English we will be writing clear, detailed instructions on how to mummify tomatoes.

We will also be writing narratives based on the discovery of an Egyptian tomb.

and division. Year 4s will
also begin learning about
measurement and area.

Science

Our science unit this half term is light. We will be learning how shadows are formed, exploring what affects the length and darkness of shadows, and investigating which materials reflect light.

History

In history, we will be learning all about Ancient Egypt, starting with chronological placement in world history. We will then be focusing on some of the key achievements of the Ancient Egyptian civilisation, including the development of farming, the building of the pyramids and the use of mummification.

RE

Our big questions is: How was the world created? We will be comparing creation stories from different cultures, religions and worldviews. The children will consider similarities, differences and their own beliefs.

Computing

In computing we will be coding and programming using Scratch. We will learn how to programme a repetition in shapes to make Egyptian amulet patterns.
