

## Year 3/4 Topic Overview- Spring 2: Stone Age

### English

Our first unit of writing in our Stone Age topic will be writing character descriptions inspired by Stone Age Boy and The Croods. We will also be doing some exciting writing activities during Book Week and using our performance skills for poetry recitals.

### Maths

Both the Year 3s and Year 4s will be beginning to learn about fractions. Year 3s will also cover mass and capacity, while Year 4s will be introduced to decimals.

### Music

In rehearsals for the Year 3/4 production we will be doing lots of singing, with a focus on clear diction, singing with control and performing with expression.

### Science

We will be finishing learning about animals (including humans) by completing our teeth experiments and drawing conclusions from the results.

Computing  
Children will use technology to create and organise digital content about the Stone Age. This could include Powerpoint or apps like Book Creator.

### Year 3/4 production

### PE

This half term the children will be practising dance in preparation for our production. We will also be doing circuits in PE to increase stamina.

### Art

As part of our Stone Age topic, we will be making our own paints and using printing techniques to create art in the style of cave paintings.

### History

In History we will be learning about changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. This will include learning about 'hunter-gatherers' and researching the culture, homes/buildings and daily life of stone age people.

### Spanish

The children will be consolidating their learning about animals and colours, then using this vocabulary in simple description.
