Year 1/2 Topic Overview- Autumn 1: Dinosaurs

English

8

We will start our English by introducing ourselves to our new teachers and classes. We will be learning about the things we need to make good quality sentences such as capital letters, finger spaces, full stops, nouns and verbs. We will then move on to some fabulous dinosaur story telling based on the book 'The Girl and the Dinosaur'.



Maths

Y1: Place value including ordering numbers and numbers of objects, using numberlines. Addition and subtraction including number bonds within 10 (including quick recall of these) and how to present these systematically.

Y2: Recapping one more, one less, number bonds within 10 and numbers to 100.

Counting in 2s, 5s, 10s and 3s. Addition and subtraction using two 2 digit numbers and related facts.

Science

We will be learning about animals including humans. We will be labelling human body parts, and exploring our senses. In later lessons, children will be thinking of (and doing) their own tests and observations they can carry out using their senses.

Geography

We will be learning and recapping the 4 countries of the UK and their capital cities. We will be exploring geographical vocabulary such as village, town, city, beach, cliff and coast. Later, we will be exploring compass directions around the school grounds and making our own coastal maps with symbols and keys.

In DT we will be working in teams to make the biggest teams to make the biggest free standing dinosaur structures possible! We will be focusing on adapting out designs to make them designs to make them stronger, stiffer and more stable.
