

Year 1/2 Topic Overview- Summer 1: Be Wild

English

We will be basing our writing around the Bewilderwood books written by Tom Blofeld. We will be writing descriptions of our favourite characters and their homes.

Maths

Year 1 will be focusing on:

- multiplication and division
- fractions
- position and direction

Year 2 will be learning about:

- Fractions
- Telling the time to the nearest 5 minutes

Science

Our unit this half term is all about plants. We will be learning the main parts of flowers and trees and identifying and classifying common wild and garden plants.

Music

We will be listening and responding to classical music and learning about when these were composed on a timeline of music.

Geography

We will be consolidating our locational knowledge of the continents and oceans, the UK and its countries, capital cities and surrounding seas. We will also be describing the location of features and routes on a map, using directional language and grid references and doing some fieldwork in our surrounding environment.

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Computing

Our focus for computing is programming. We will be using Scratch to make plant growth simulations.

PE

This half term, our PE focus is:

- Athletics
- Orienteering and teamwork

RE

Our big question is: How do we welcome babies in to the world? We will be learning about Christian baptism and Humanist naming ceremonies

Spanish

We will be learning Spanish greetings, how to ask and give our names and how to answer simple questions.

PSHE

- This half term our PSHE unit is all about working together. We will be learning to celebrate our own skills and achievements and will be focusing on developing and practicing communication and group work skills including discussion, negotiation and co-operation.

Art

We will be doing an artist study on Andy Goldsworthy and creating sculpture and collage inspired by him, using natural materials.
