You should include:

- A list of ingredients.
- Directions for how to make it
- Design the bottle, label and packaging
- Explain how your potion is used and what the effect is (good or bad...?!)

Pottermore Potion Guide Cure For Boils

Ingredients Needed:

- 1x Porcupine Quills
- 1x Snake Fangs
- 1x Horned Slugs

Instructions:

1. Add 6 Snake Fangs to the mortar
2. Crush into a fine powder using the pestle
3. Add 4 measures of the crushed fangs to your cauldron
4. Heat the mixture to 250 for 10 seconds
5. Wave your wand

Leave to brew and return in 80 minutes

1. Add 4 Horned Slugs to your cauldron
2. Add 2 Porcupine Quills to your cauldron
3. Stir 5 times, clockwise
4. Wave your wand to complete the potion

what you value most in life.

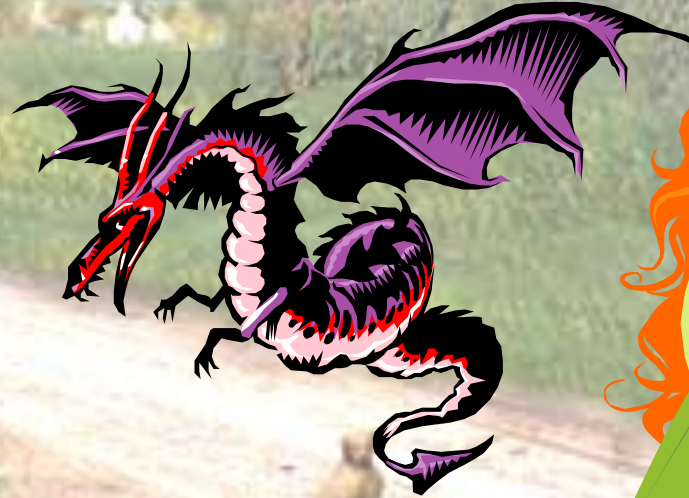
