

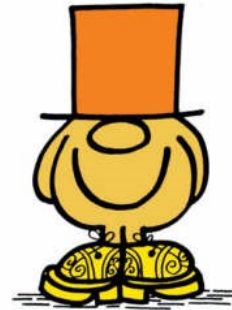

It means: Extremely angry; furious.

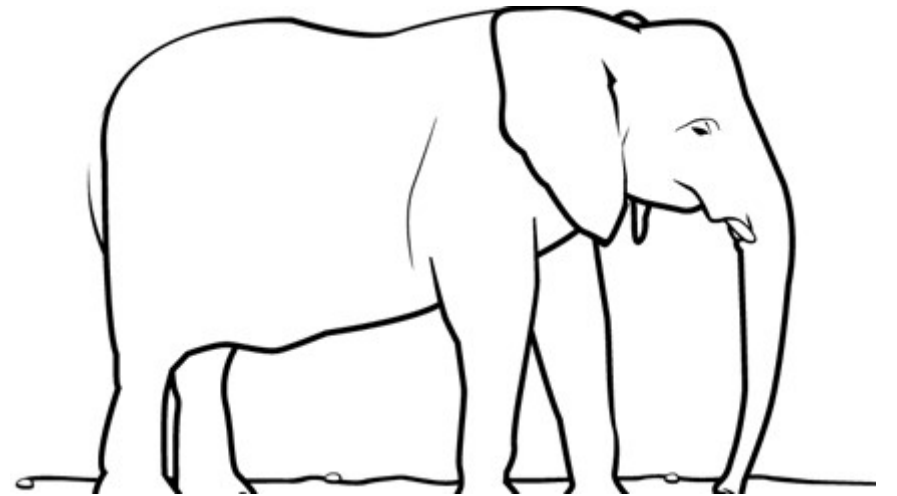

of something

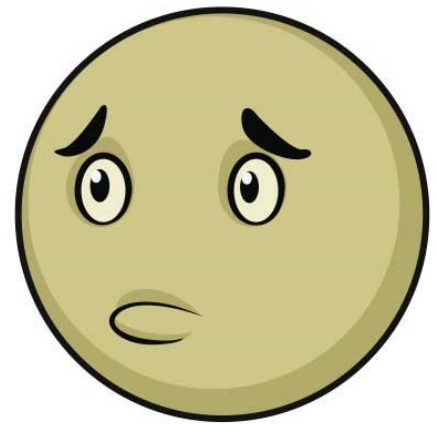

It means: Extremely bad

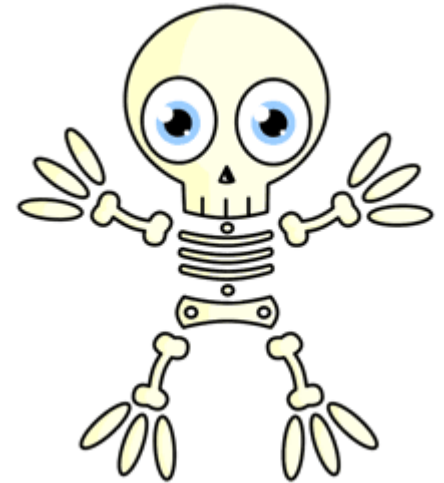

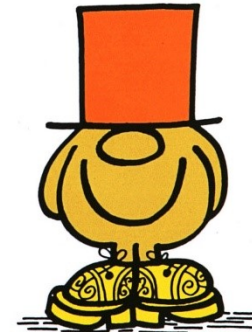

something

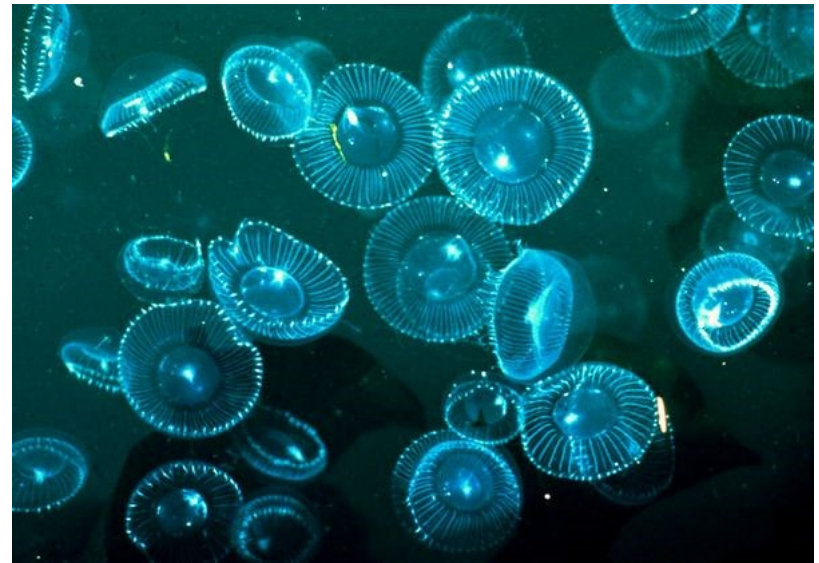
