




We are early readers

We choose a book that we like.






We read left to right, top to bottom.





We enjoy looking at the pictures.




We turn pages one at a time.

900 minutes in a school year

282,000 words

Child 'C' reads 20 minutes each day

3,600 minutes in a school year

1,800,000 words
