



Seesaw – A home users guide



Seesaw is a learning platform used by the school to facilitate two-way communication in a secure manner between school and families. It allows all children to have their own account, set within their class. It provides a private platform between you and your child's teaching team. We share a weekly highlight on Seesaw so parents are kept up to date and get a flavour of what children have been learning about or something that we have been busy doing.

As Seesaw has proven to be such an effective way to share information with parents, we encourage all parents to use Seesaw regularly to share any learning, achievements or exciting happenings at home. Therefore we suggest all parents enable notifications on their Seesaw account/device so they never miss the latest Reception news.

Jim A's Home Learning Code

1. Go to <https://app.seesaw.me> on a computer. Or install the Seesaw **Class App** on an iOS or Android device.



2. Choose "I'm a Student".



3. Scan this code using Seesaw's built-in QR code scanner. Or type in these letters to access your Seesaw account: **VT KU OJ XR PS IB EA RB**



Ask your teacher for a new code after November 23, 2021.

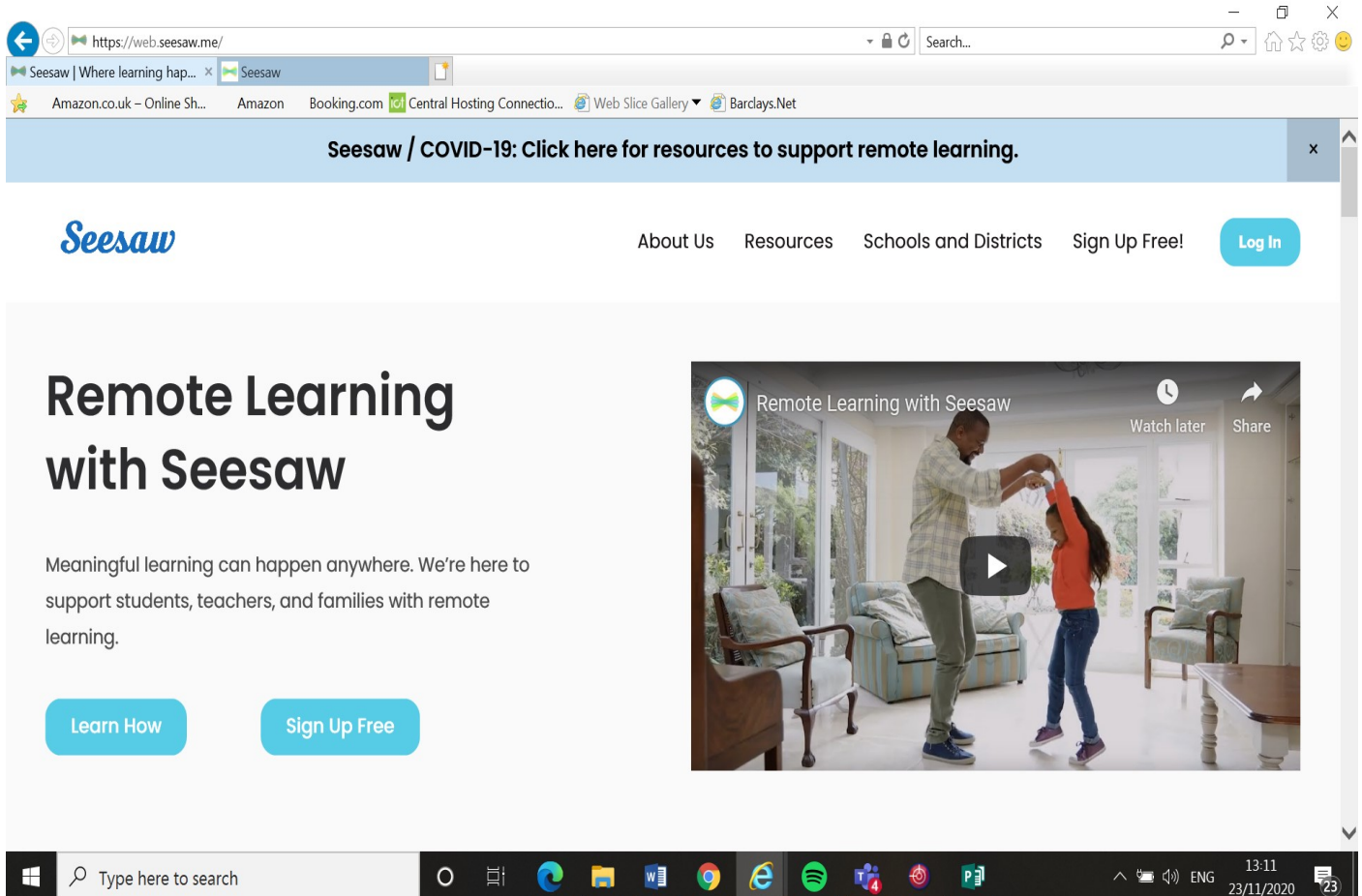
This code is a password. If you have this code, you can access this account. Do not post codes on social media or in any publicly accessible place on the Internet!

As clearly stated on the bottom of the sheet, please be careful with this code, as anyone with access to it can access your child's Seesaw account.

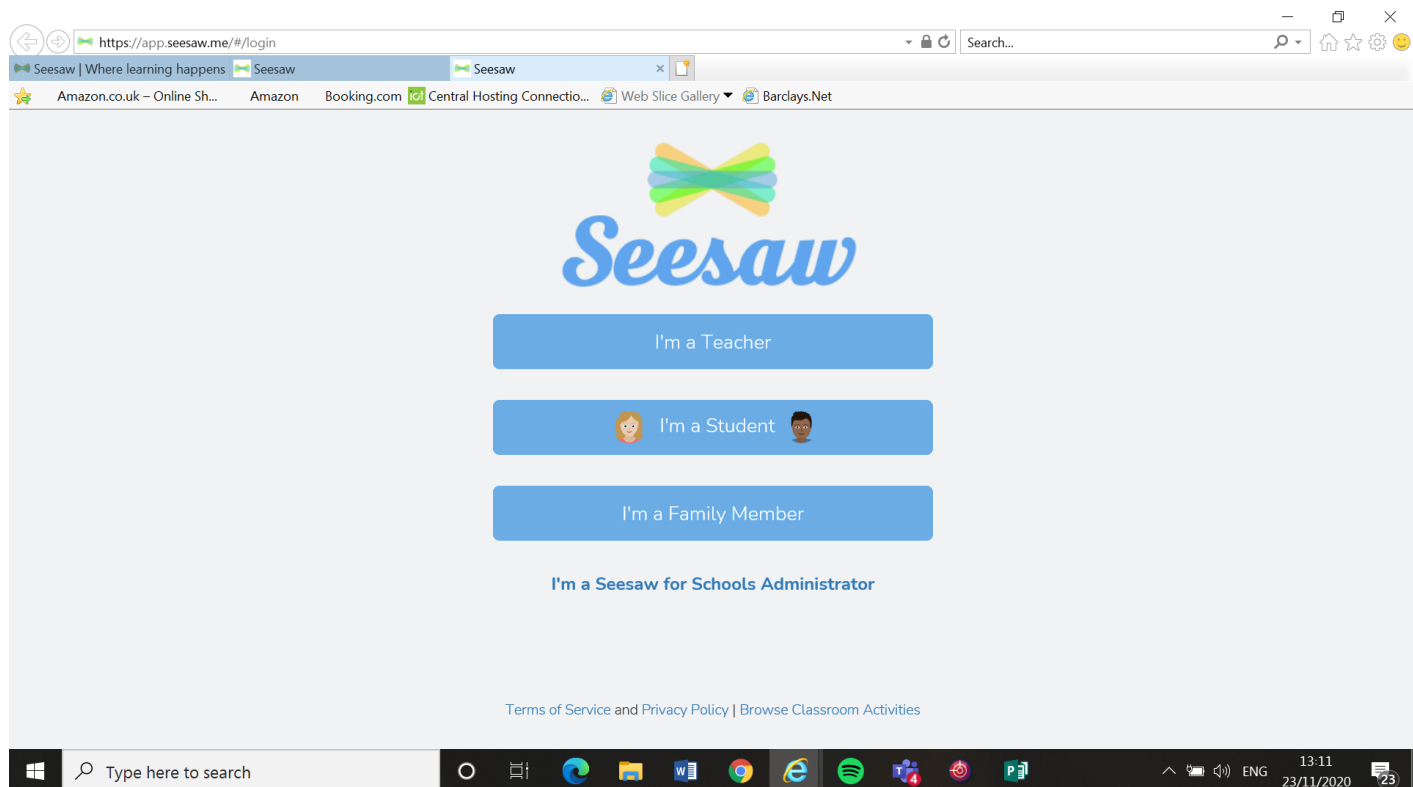
If lost, please ask your class teacher for a new code.



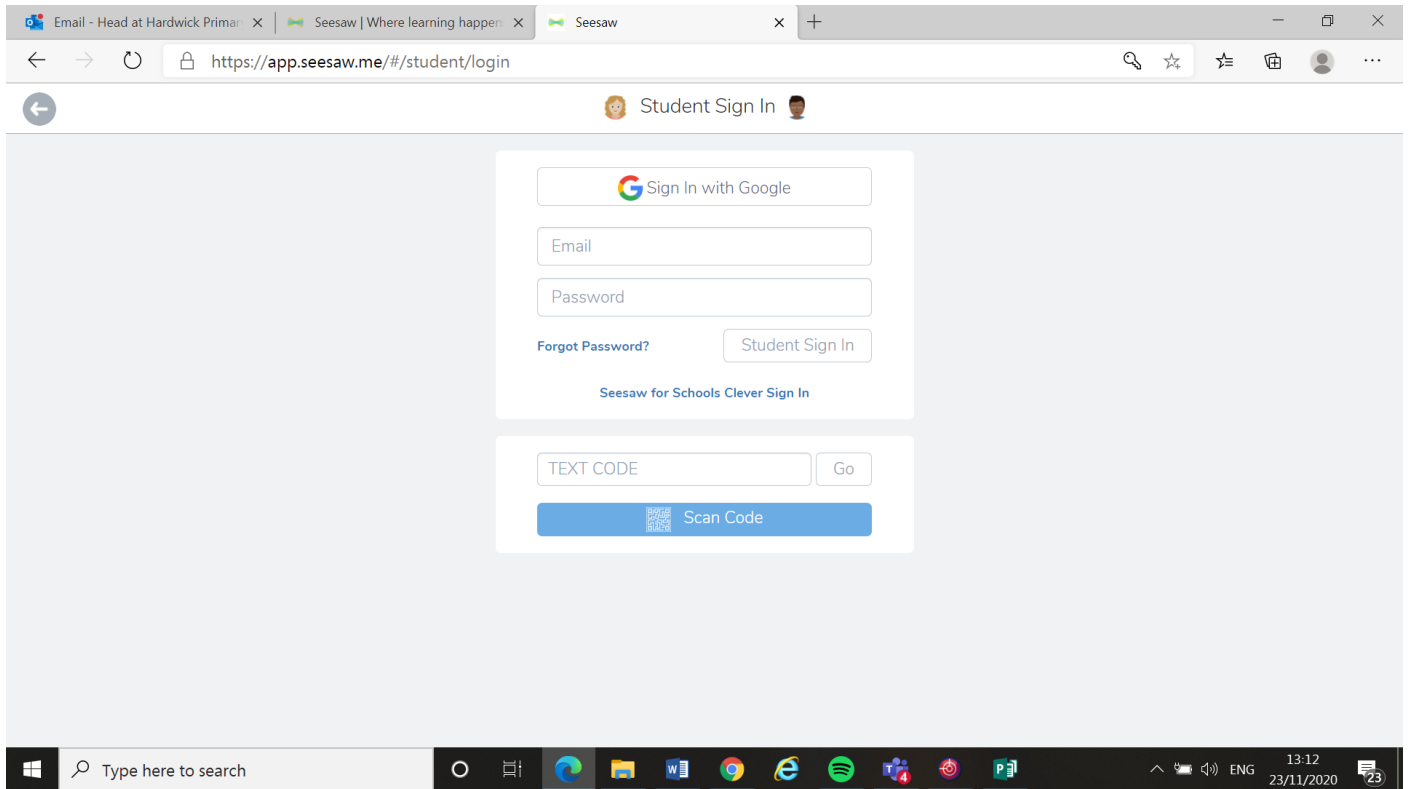
To login, go to the Seesaw website:

Logging on brings up this screen. This is your child's account 'home screen'. It will display:

- Their name (top left, 'Pete Tod')
- Their class (top right, 'C2')
- Three main sections (right hand side)
 - * Journal— a log of all activity related to their account— similar to a social media feed.
 - * Activities— this is where you will find weekly highlights and holiday challenges.
 - * Inbox— This is where any other messages or notifications will appear. For example, when a teacher sends a photo of something your child has done at school which they are really proud of, a notification will be sent here.
