## Spelling Activities ks1

1) Make a word search with your words. List them underneath in your book.	2) Write a silly rhyme for each of your words in your book.	3) Use each word in a silly sentence and underline the spelling.	4) Sit back to back with a partner and see how many words you can each spell from your list.	5) Play hangman in your book with a partner using spellings from your list.	6) Write all your spellings in different colours and styles (fonts) in your book.
7) Draw a picture or shape and then fill the middle with your spellings to make a 'wordle'.	8) Use an elastic band to tie 2 different coloured pens/pencils together. Then write your spellings with your 'double' pencil.	9) Sprinkle talcum powder/flour/rice into a baking tray and use your finger to spell out the words.	10) With a partner decide on a spelling and get a ball. Throw the ball to each other as you say a letter of the word. Keep going until you have spelt the whole word.	11) Cut pieces of paper into thin strips. Write each word on to a strip and make a colourful paper chain.	12) Draw a large spider in your book. Write your spellings along its 8 legs and inside its belly!
13) Using paints, paint your spellings into the book.	14) Using chalk, write your spellings outside on the floor or wall.	15) Draw a rainbow in your book. Write all your words in each arc using different colours for each arc.	16) Create a table in your book and make 5 columns with the headings 'look, cover, say, write, check' and see how many you can spell correctly.	17) Draw round your hand in your book and fill it in with your spellings in all different colours.	18) Draw yourself a treasure chest and a bin. Make some coins with your spellings on and some with made up words. Can you sort them correctly between the chest and then bin?
19) Write a short story in your book using each of the words from your list.	20) Draw a square and write your spellings in it around the edge, keep going until you reach the middle of the square.	21) Use a dictionary to find the definition of each of your spellings and write them in your book.	22) Play charades with your words when someone has guessed it move on to the next word.	23) Arrange your words and write them in alphabetical order in a list in your book.	24) Draw a long snake in your book and fill in its body with all of your spellings.
